We know that the whole creation has been groaning in labor pains until now; and not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the first fruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly while we wait for adoption, the redemption of our bodies. 
~ Romans 8:22-23



From the Pastor's Desk



The above verses are not your usual Christmas scripture passage, and this is not your usual Christmas season newsletter article! In his letter to the Romans, Paul talks about God birthing something new through our faith in Christ even as we await our final redemption. It reminds me of one of my favorite lines in "O Little Town of Bethlehem": "O holy child of Bethlehem,

descend to us, we pray; cast out our sin, and enter in, be born in us today." What a powerful reminder that each Christmas we do not simply retell the story of a special baby boy being born in Bethlehem 2000+ years ago, but that Christ continues to live through us now.

At our Church Council retreat in October this year, we asked what might be born in us to help further Faith's mission to preach, teach, and share God's love in Christ into the future. Through prayer, discussion, and Bible study, we discerned three priorities for the coming year:

- 1) More diversity in our worshippers which includes age, ethnic, and gender diversity
- 2) More youth activities which includes youth-led worship, Bible studies, and fun events

3) Community outreach, both to newcomers to our immediate vicinity and service projects in the larger Long Island community

It is exciting to see already how our work on these priorities might come to fruition, and what God might do with us in 2023. In this season of celebrating Christ being born as a human who lived among us, let's remember that the church is the body of Christ. That means we need you, a member of his body, to help us carry out our work in his name! Please let me know if any of these areas sparks your curiosity and interest. #### Stewardship

It is an old Chinese custom that near the end of the year a man would make every effort to pay all of his past debts, in order that he might begin the New Year with a clean slate, owing no one.



To us, "near the end of the year" means the Christmas season, and it is more often than not a time of running up new bills rather than paying old ones. We buy toys for the children; gifts for friends and relatives. We often invest in a major purchase for the family, a flat-screen TV or a larger refrigerator, and take on new payments for another 24 to 36 months. This is our custom in the season of giving.

We give to those we love to express our love, on the birthday of the one who taught us what love is all about. But, too often, gift giving becomes an end in itself, a custom without meaning, a distraction, a Santa Claus thing, and we lose sight of Love with a capital L. We forget about God! The end of the year is an excellent time to re-appraise our giving to God.



Why not adopt the old Chinese custom? Let us assume our obligation to re-pay God, in light of all that God has given us. And, in the spirit of our Lord's birthday, let us see what gift of self we can give out of our love. We know by now what our annual income is or will be, as well as how much we have

given to God, both through the church and through worthy charities.

Ask if the amount I have given truly represents what I think of Almighty God? Does it represent my love, my gratitude, my repentance, my acts of self-denial, my crosses and joys?



In this season of giving, we should take time to reappraise what we have offered God this year. Let's use tithing as a measure, an acceptable standard, and determine now if our gift of love is worthy of us.
