I have never been a fan of horror movies, but I do like Halloween. All of us have different thresholds for what we can tolerate or enjoy that's "scary." Of course, some of the things that I used to be afraid of as a kid I am no longer afraid of (most of the time): the dark, loud fireworks, meeting new people. As we age, our fears may change, but we all still have them. We worry about the state of our country and world. We have concerns about our personal finances. 
